VENDU (AUCTION) ROLL OF AGATHA BLOM - WIFE OF LUCAS MEYER  
23 JUNE 1774

Dr Antonia Malan made us a very kind offer in 'Capensis' 2/95 page 11. I duly posted my empty diskette to her and it returned promptly with the Index of Venduollen on it. Not having the Microsoft Word 5 programme, I did, with a little difficulty, manage to read the names and references through another word-processing package.

To my delight I found listed the auction of the deceased estate of my ancestress, Agatha Blom, whereupon I duly rushed to the Archives to follow up the reference. Agatha was the wife of the first of the South African Meyers to bear the name, Lucas. She was the firstborn child of Barend Pieterse Blom of Wagenaar. Her baptismal date was 21.10.1695 (DeVP p64), so she must have been approximately 78-79 years old when she died. The home in which the auction was held was possibly have been that of her daughter, Maria Elisabeth (DeVP p574 c7), whose second marriage was to Willem Kruger.

The great value to me of the list of household items is the fact that at last I can picture the possessions of my town-dwelling ancestress. Interesting too, are the names of the purchasers of the items and the possible relationship of the four slaves sold to three different owners - was it a family that was fragmented? Imagine the indignity of being sold 'voetstoots' (at buyer's risk)!

Public auction held by the Office of the Orphan Chamber of the Cape of Good Hope on 23 June 1774 at the house of the burger, Wilhelmus de Kruger, of the deceased estate of the late Agatha Blom, wife of the late Lucas Meyer, goods sold to the highest bidders, namely -
